Connecting Employers and Job Seekers

The PinellasWorks program provides an opportunity to connect employers and job seekers who have been impacted by COVID-19. The program offers 100 percent reimbursement of costs associated with training new employees and, an opportunity for job seekers to learn new skills and get back to work.



Overview

Pinellas County received **\$170** million in federal CARES funding to address the community's most pressing needs related to COVID-19. The expanded Pinellas Cares business program is part of a larger series of programs funded by the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The PinellasWorks program is supported by **\$2 million** of the CARES Act Funding, provided by Pinellas County, and will be administered and managed by CareerSource Pinellas. There is no cost to the employer or the job seeker.

Benefits:

- **200** Pinellas County residents receive onthe-job training and/or short term training leading to full time, permanent employment
- **50** local employers receive **100** percent reimbursement of wages associated with training a new employee through December 15, 2020
- **\$2,000** Retention incentive to the employer for hiring full-time, permanent after the training
