- Take TABE test (If applicable)
- Schedule an appointment with a WIOA Career counselor.
- Service are based upon available funding

ELIGIBILITY SCREENING:

- Are 18 years or older
- Are a Pinellas County Resident
- Meet U.S. Citizen or permanent resident requirements.
- Are a recently separated veteran (Separated within the last 48 months)
- Served on active duty for a period of more than 180 days and was discharged or released without a dishonorable discharge
- Are not retired from the military
- Working at a wage less than 80% of your earnings while serving in the military
- Receiving, eligible for or exhausted reemployment assistance benefits (Dislocated Worker)
